Accommodation

Thompson Court is a residential service featuring 3 fully furnished and modern bedrooms. There are two bedrooms on the first floor and one bedroom on the second floor. Each bedroom is equipped with an en-suite bathroom. There is a communal lounge and communal kitchen. People We Support use the spacious communal kitchen to cook up a feast, fully equipped with an oven, air-fryer, and microwave. People We Support can choose to eat individually or communally with peers and / or staff.

Thompson Court has a rear garden which hosts a smoking shelter at the back of the garden. Netflix is provided for each resident in the home. At Thompson Court, we arrange activities with the people we support. We arrange monthly resident meetings where residents inform us of what they would like to do in the upcoming month. We have an inclusion officer who arranges activities that People We Support have the opportunity to engage in. Each person's culture and beliefs are represented and valued.

Community activities include, cinema, swimming, bowling, gym, shopping centre, day trips outside of Cardiff e.g. zoo.
