Accomplish's Burton Grange Residential service is part of Keys Group, a family of care and support providers who share a common goal of delivering the best outcomes for those who choose our care.

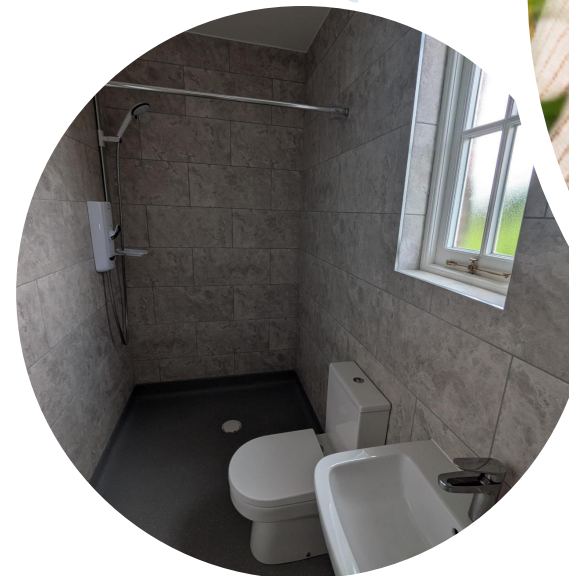
