

Manor Lodge

Manor Lodge is a large residential property in Newport, providing support to adults with acquired brain injuries, mental health conditions, learning disabilities and other dual diagnosis. The service does not stand still but focuses on rehabilitation and have supported many individuals to achieve their goal of leaving a care setting and returning to the community to live with their families. In a report on 20/06/2025, the Responsible Person Representative from MHFA Wales Advocacy commented "I am confident that you support this person appropriately and have no concerns about her needs being met. I also know you work in the least restrictive way possible and uphold her ability to make her own choices where she can."

There are 6 large ensuite rooms and one independent basement flat with a lounge-diner and en-suite bedroom. The property has a large garden and is within walking distance of local shops and we are just minutes away from our GP, two hospitals and the city centre, which is easily accessible by walking, public transport or in our own vehicle. We support Pets as Therapy and have our very own cat called Alfie who is the purr-fect addition to our home, and everyone here loves him and spoils him rotten!

Danielle Powell is the Registered Manager and has been with the company for 12 years, having been a support worker in 3 of our 4 Newport homes, progressing to acting manager at Manor Lodge before taking on the role in October 2019.
